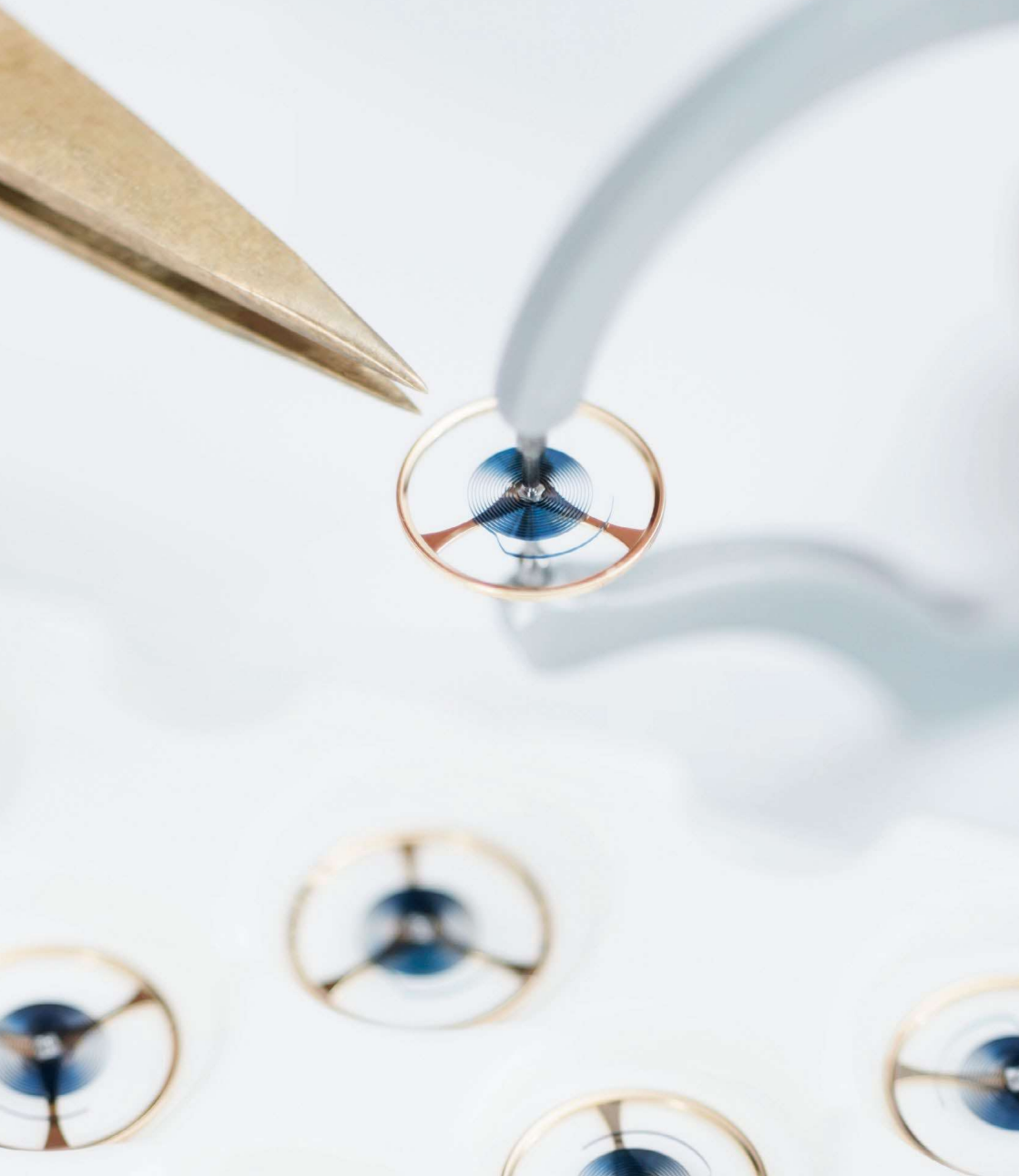

DUW 6101

High-end mechanics from Glashütte: the first neomatik caliber with a date. At only 3.6 millimeters in height, DUW 6101 is extremely slender. This automatic caliber has been redesigned from start to finish, and the patented date mechanism has been integrated into it. The date can be set quickly and easily, forwards or backwards.

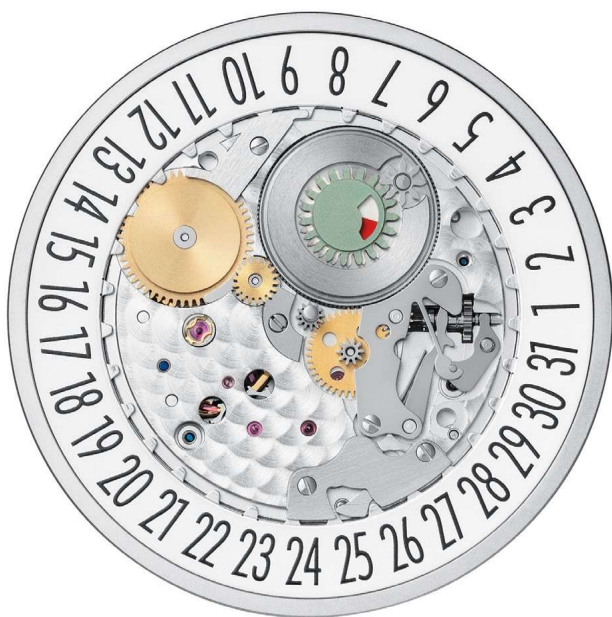

The first tick of a new era: In-house caliber DUW 4401 was the first watch movement from NOMOS Glashütte to feature the proprietary escapement called the NOMOS swing system. The hand-wound caliber includes two patented NOMOS complications: a date display and power reserve display.

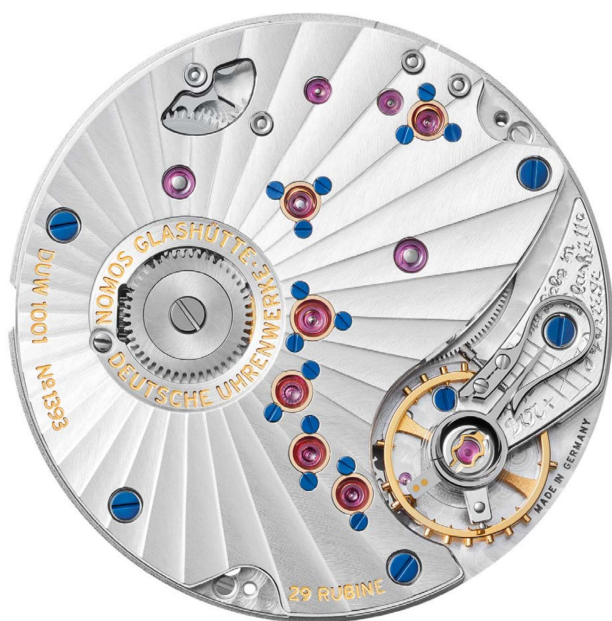

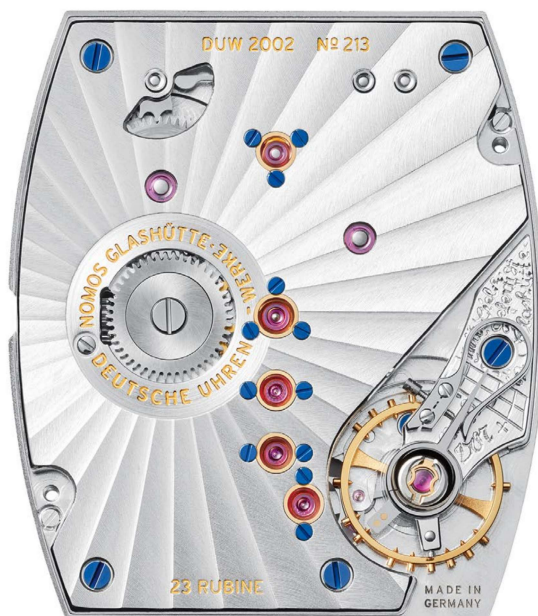

DUW 1001

Manually-wound movement DUW 1001 is constructed according to the rules of Glashütte fine watchmaking and produced exclusively for the gold model Lambda. It is a work of art in itself: This movement requires rewinding only twice a week since the twin mainspring barrel ensures a power reserve of 84 hours—elegantly displayed on the dial by the beautiful power reserve indicator.



DUW 2002

An exquisite form movement that fills the golden case of the NOMOS model Lux perfectly. Hand-wound caliber DUW 2002 is equipped with a twin mainspring barrel with a power reserve of 3.5 days—the best you can find at NOMOS Glashütte. The hand-engraved message on the balance cock reads “Mit Liebe in Glashütte gefertigt”—“lovingly made in Glashütte,” in other words.

Sundial



Stainless steel sundial

The lowest-priced NOMOS caliber from Glashütte: You can wear the beautiful stainless steel ring with a 19-millimeter diameter either on your finger or with a leather cord around your neck. What time is it? Set the correct month in the middle ring on the hole, then turn it towards the sun so that light falls onto the hole. A ray of light on the inside of the sundial ring will show the time.
